



## **KWSL CORE Committee Representatives**

The CORE Project was presented at the 2019 KWSL AGM and participation was voted in by Team Managers with an 83% majority. As informed at the AGM, volunteers from the KWSL membership are required to become committee representatives. At March 4, 2020, two committee members are now required.

A KWSL Committee Member is to be a representative of the KWSL and will conduct themselves in a professional manner with the intent to represent the best interests of the League. The Committee members will attend KWSL Executive meetings every second month, beginning April 2020, to provide an update to the executive team on the committee outcomes.

### **Fund-Raising Committee**

- This volunteer commitment is for the term March 4, 2020 to December 31, 2020.
- Committee Goal: Raise \$2 million.
- Meetings: 8 - 10 times for an hour during the term. Location will be at some commonly agreed to location - as yet undetermined.
- The person should be connected to the donor community and unafraid to ask others to invest in the building.

### **Operations Committee**

- This volunteer commitment has a variable term.
- The first project (March/April) is to quantify the inventory and cost of furnishing required for the building. This involves researching products and making choices.
- The second project is to work with the KMSL and CORE to apply for a Capital Gaming Grant to get lights on R1 and R3 in Rutland.
- The final project is to create an Operations Manual for the building. This group will eventually become the group that makes decisions relating to the building (eg. who is on R1 and R3, where profits go, how the annual revenue and expenditures are working against budget, etc.)
